**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY MAINTENANCE WORKS  
M1 Junction 19 to Junction 21 – both directions**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential safety maintenance works on the M1 between junction 19 and junction 21 in both directions. During this work, we will be upgrading the barrier in the central reserve.

**When will the work take place?**

Our work is due to start **10 January 2022** and is scheduled for completion by **mid April 2022**. To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise inconvenience and disruption to the local community, residents, and road users, we will work between **8pm** and **6am Monday to Friday**.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

**How will the work affect traffic?**

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and road users, we will need to close some lanes however at least 1 lane will be kept running at all times.

**We will NOT be closing the motorway and traffic will NOT be diverted.**
