- Leicestershire Police in partnership with Blaby district council and impact team were able to identify areas in the community where young people are perceived to be engaged in anti-social behaviour and to work with these young people through street based workers, to prevent offending and reduce anti-social behaviour. The positive results are forthcoming and it is evident with the reduction of ASB calls we received. Blaby precinct continues to be our focal attention.

- What you told us
We had several reports of youths damaging fences at whetstone especially during Friday nights.
We also received youths riding motor Bikes on Oakfield Park in Blaby.

What we did

Targeted patrols were planned and executed at the right time and right place preventing youths committing ASB. We also have received letter of thanks from local residents.

Few youths riding motor bikes were identified by local enquiries and their parents were spoken and warning letters were sent out. Two suspects were arrested following reports of Burglary dwelling in Glenparva. In addition three people were arrested for breaking into a HGV vehicle in whetstone.
