Force updates

Leicestershire Police and the Road Safety Partnership has launched a brand new road safety campaign encouraging all road users to respect each other. The initiative known as, 'Share the Road' focuses on every type of road user, from rambler and horse rider to motorist and cyclist. It aims to reduce the number of traffic collisions and foster mutual respect among all those who use the roads.

As part of the national Surveillance Camera Day, Leicestershire Police is urging people to fill in a new [survey about automatic number plate recognition \(ANPR\)](#) technology. Surveillance Camera Day is a national event to raise awareness about surveillance cameras, why they are used and who is using them and generate a debate about how they are used. It's a conversation about how camera technology is evolving especially around facial recognition and artificial intelligence and what the benefits and risks are.

Community Consultation

You told us about:

Many residents have complained about youths riding motor bikes and electric scooters in and around Blaby, Whetstone, Glen Parva and Cosby area.

Increase in vehicle crimes especially in Whetstone is a source of concern for many residents.

What we did:

Targeted patrols were conducted in affected areas and 2 Section 59 warnings have been issued to alleged perpetrators. We have also identified those involved and their parents have been approached and appropriate action taken.

Officers in plain clothes were deployed during nights to catch offenders.

Two suspects were arrested who were involved in a robbery in Cosby.
